He was born on October 31, 1936 in the village Negrilesti, Galati, Romania.

In 1959 he graduated the University of Bucharest, Faculty of Mathematics.

From 1959 to 1963 he worked as an assistant professor at the Faculty of Mathematics of the Bucharest University. In the period 1963-1975 he worked at Institute of Mathematics in Bucharest. During the period 1975-1990 he worked at INCREST and since 1990 by now, he works as a senior researcher at the Institute of Mathematics of the Romanian Academy.

In 1965 he received the Ph.D. degree in mathematics from the University of Bucharest with a thesis on stability of differential equations with random parameters.

He is the author or coauthor of four monographs and over 150 scientific papers dedicated to various topics on Differential Equations and Control Theory.

In 1972 he was awarded the "Gh. Lazar" prize of the Romanian Academy.
